The Seal of the Stained Glass Association of America is the mark of excellence within the trade. Accredited Craft Supplier/Manufacture Members of the Stained Glass Association of America may display the Seal with the words “Accredited Member.”



Fully Accredited Membership is now open and applications are being accepted for review for the Summer Business Meeting. Applications may be downloaded from the SGAA website at www.stainedglass.org or obtained by calling the SGAA Headquarters at 800.438.9581.

In order to meet the objectives of the Stained Glass Association of America and to also meet the laws established for 501 (c) (6) Professional Trade Associations, all voting members must be accredited or be in the process of applying for accreditation.

Fully Accredited Members include the Accredited Full Service Studio, the Accredited Artist/Designer and the Accredited Craft Supplier/Manufacturer. Each category must meet specific criteria as established by the Membership Committee. The applicant must establish a general reputation for integrity, financial responsibility, business practices and quality of craftsmanship and has been appraised to be such as to reflect credit upon the Association.

As a Fully Accredited Member of the SGAA, the Accredited Craft Supplier/Manufacturer must be an owner, partner, principal or appointee of a firm that has been actively distributing and/or manufacturing materials and/or products used in the stained and/or decorative art glass craft for a minimum of four years.

Fully Accredited Members may display the seal with the gold background and the words Fully Accredited Member. The application process for Fully Accredited Members is designed for the major studio including studio inspection and on site inspection of installed projects.

Fully Accredited Members, if qualified are eligible for all elective offices. Fully Accredited Members in good standing and present at any General Membership Conference are eligible to have two votes on any issue that is brought before the conference.

Fully Accredited Members must maintain their accreditation by attending an annual Summer Conference once every three years. Fully Accredited Members must also submit for display at least once every three years a project board of work installed within the last three years. Restoration work must be identified as such.
