The Stained Glass Association of America for over 100 years has been a professional trade association and for the past 50 years has been a 501 c 6 non-profit corporation which mandates an accreditation process. By maintaining the highest possible standards of quality and craftsmanship through an accreditation process, our members uphold the craft in such a way as to reflect honor upon the profession. This is done with the understanding that such practices will help guarantee the patrons of the craft that the product and services they purchase are of the highest standard and thereby both advance the reputation of the profession and insure that it can continue to be practiced with dignity and pride.

The Associate Membership is the preliminary level for application to Accredited Membership requiring a basic confirmation of the viability of the studio as an existing business of two or more years.

Benefits of Associate Membership

- 4 issues of *The Kaleidoscope*.
- Access to *SGAA Online* the Members Only Website.
- Listings in *Alpha Sourcebook Directory*.
- The right to hold one vote when voting on all SGAA matters put before the membership.

Step One

Submit complete application, supporting materials and a \$200 fee. No individual shall hold membership in the Associate Member Category for longer than two calendar years during which time the applicant must apply for accredited membership or elect to become an affiliate or a member of the Craftsman Category if qualified.

Step Two

Required submissions will be reviewed by the membership committee and approved by the Executive Board within 30 days of submission. In the case that a submission is declined, the membership chair will notify the applicant as to the reason with suggestions for resubmission.

Applicants shall meet specific criteria and supply supporting documents as established by the Membership Committee and approved by the Executive Board of the SGAA.

Associate Member: Applicant shall be an owner, partner or principal of a custom stained or art glass studio for at least two years, have a reputation for integrity, financial responsibility and quality craftsmanship. Materials submitted must prove that the studio is a vital business that has been in operation for a minimum of two years.

Associate Applications will be considered within 30 days of the application's receipt into the SGAA Headquarters

Application for Associate Membership Required Supporting Materials

I. Each applicant shall submit at least two of the following materials:

1. Business License.
2. Sales permit, sales/use tax certificate, etc.
3. Proof of liability insurance.
4. A current certificate of commercial/liability/worker's compensation insurance coverage.
